"Therefore He is able to save completely those who come to God through Him, because He always lives to intercede for them". Hebrews 7 v 25

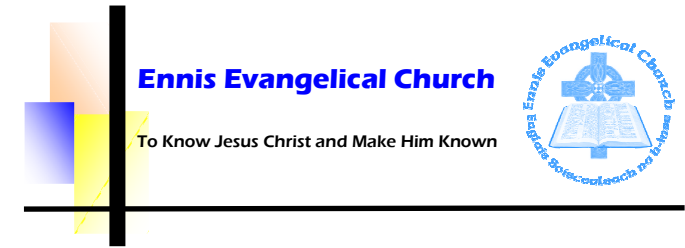
THEREFORE:
