

Ever been in the situation where you know your love for God is strong and you are longing to serve God and do His will, then you hit a storm in your life. Is it normal for Christians to face storms in their lives? Yes, and these may result from our own actions or come out of the blue to us not of our doing. The big question is how do we react in those situations?

Even lesus disciples encountered troubles. lesus has just fed the 5,000 and they would have been on a spiritual high having witnessed Jesus working a miracle. Matthew 14:22 "Immediately Jesus made the disciples get into the boat and go on ahead of Him to the other side, while He dismissed the crowd." The disciples were obedient and got into the boat to cross the sea. Unknown to them, Jesus had just sent them off into a storm while He went up the mountain to pray for them, for the test they were about to undergo. They were to learn how to identify Jesus in the storm. They could see Jesus in His work of miracles, healing, forgiving sins, bring salvation, providing, His power over Satan, but when the storm hit and they felt alone, where was lesus? The boat was tossing about in strong winds, and they were depending on their own ability to get themselves out of the storm and it did not look good for them. Just before dawn Jesus walked on the water to them. In the disciples fear they thought they saw a ghost because they were not expecting to see Jesus. Jesus spoke and told them to have courage and not be afraid. Only when Jesus was in the boat with them, did the disciples see Him for who He is and worship Him saying "Truly you are the Son of God".

When we are in the darkest storms of our lives we could also be in danger of seeing a ghost and not recognising Jesus, if we are not expecting Him to be with us. In the storm we cannot rely on our own strength and must look to Jesus and trust and rest in His power and take shelter under His wing until the trouble passes. Jesus is with us in the storm, we are not alone and He will bring us safely through it. Hebrews 13:5 "For God has said "I will never fail you. I will never abandon you." God is not remote but close to us. Psalm 139:5 "You hem me in from behind and before; You lay Your hand upon me"


